Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are writing to inform you of an important change regarding our school bus pass process, starting with the **2025/2026 academic year**. Students must retain their bus pass from the **24/25** school year as the Cowichan Valley School District will provide only **one** bus pass the **first** time a student is enrolled in the transportation service.

#### What's Changing?

Beginning in the 2025/2026 academic school year, bus passes will no longer be reissued annually. Instead, your student will be expected to keep their current pass from 20242/2025 academic year and reuse the same bus pass from year to year.

#### **How to Keep the Bus Pass in Good Condition**

To help protect the pass and ensure its longevity, we strongly recommend placing it is a plastic protective cover.

#### **Lost or Damaged Passes**

The replacement fee for lost and altered passes is \$10.00. Payment can be made for replacement passes via e-transfer to <a href="mailto:buspasspayments@sd79.bc.ca">buspasspayments@sd79.bc.ca</a> or by credit card at 250-748-1066 ext. 276. #### School Fees 2025/2026

The Board of Education reviews fees for schools and academies every school year. The *School Act* section 82 permits a Board to charge a deposit for educational resources. Boards may also charge fees for materials, supplies, equipment and instruments not considered educational resource materials. Schools may charge deposits for materials given to students and provide refunds upon return.


